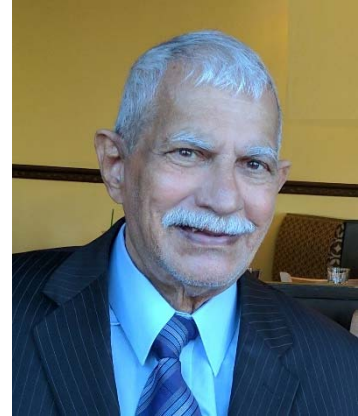


In loving memory of
